

## Jesus is the God of Israel

Why is this important to know that Jesus Christ was the God of Heaven, the Father, the Creator of all things?

Answer: So we know the significance of the sacrifice he made dying for us.

**Who does the Bible refer to as God? Compare these titles and names for God the Father, and see who it says God is in the Book of Mormon.**

<p><b>The Bible Calls God 'God.'</b></p>	<p><b>The Book of Mormon shares that Jesus Christ is God. Jesus was and is God in the flesh. Because we could not be with Him in Perfection because of our sin, he chose to take on Flesh, (a mortal body) to be with us instead.</b></p>
<p><a href="#">Genesis 6:45</a> And Enoch continued his speech, saying, The Lord which spake with me, the same is the <b>God of heaven</b>, and he is my <b>God</b> and your <b>God</b>, and ye are my brethren; and why counsel ye yourselves, and deny the <b>God of heaven</b>?</p>	<p><a href="#">3 Nephi 9:19</a> And behold they began to pray; and they did pray unto Jesus, <b>calling him their Lord and their God.</b></p> <p><a href="#">1 Nephi 5:251</a> And as for those who are at Jerusalem, saith the prophet, they shall be scourged by all people, <b>because they crucify the God of Israel</b>, and turn their hearts aside, rejecting signs and wonders, and power and glory of the God of Israel;</p> <p><a href="#">2 Nephi 7:7</a> <b>And there is none other nation on earth that would crucify their God.</b></p> <p><b><u>Mosiah chapter 8 provides the definition why Jesus is called 'The Son.'</u> It is because he takes on flesh and becomes mortal.</b></p> <p><a href="#">Mosiah 8:13</a> Have they not said that <b>God himself should come down among the children of men, and take upon him the form of man</b>, and go forth in mighty power upon the face of the earth?</p> <p><a href="#">Mosiah 8:28</a> And now Abinadi said unto them, <b>I would that ye should understand that God himself shall come down among the children of men, and shall redeem his people;</b></p> <p><b><u>29 And because he dwelleth in flesh, he shall be called the Son of God:</u></b></p> <p><a href="#">30</a> And having subjected the flesh to the will of the Father, being the Father and the Son; the Father because he was conceived by the power of God: and the Son, because of the flesh; <b>thus becoming the Father and Son:</b></p> <p><a href="#">31</a> And <b>they are one God, yea, the very eternal Father of heaven and of earth;</b></p>

## God the Father?

The Bible Calls God ' <u>God the Father.</u> '	The Book of Mormon shares that Jesus Christ is <u>God the Father.</u>
<p><a href="#">Mark 9:35</a> And whosoever shall receive me, receiveth not me only, but him that sent me, even <b>the Father</b>.</p> <p><a href="#">Matthew 28:18</a> Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of <b>the Father</b>, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost;</p> <p><a href="#">John 1:16</a> For in the beginning was the Word, even the Son, who is made flesh, and sent unto us by the will of <b>the Father</b>. And as many as believe on his name shall receive of his fullness. And of his fullness have all we received, even immortality and eternal life, through his grace.</p> <p><a href="#">John 1:18</a> For the law was after a carnal commandment, to the administration of death; but the gospel was after the power of an endless life, through Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son, who is in the bosom of <b>the Father</b>.</p> <p><a href="#">John 3:35</a> <b>The Father</b> loveth the Son, and hath given all things into his hands.</p> <p><a href="#">John 5:26</a> For as <b>the Father</b> hath life in himself, so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;</p> <p><a href="#">John 6:44</a> No man can come unto me, except he doeth the will of my Father who hath sent me. And this is the will of him who hath sent me, that ye receive the Son; for <b>the Father</b> beareth record of him; and he who receiveth the testimony, and doeth the will of him who sent me, I will raise up in the resurrection of the just.</p> <p><a href="#">John 6:46</a> <b>Not that any man hath seen the Father, save he which is of God, he hath seen the Father.</b></p> <p><a href="#">John 14:8</a> Philip saith unto him, Lord, show us the Father, and <b>it sufficeth us.</b></p>	<p><a href="#">Matthew 11:28</a> All things are delivered unto me of my Father; <b>and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and they to whom the Son will reveal himself; they shall see the Father also.</b></p> <p><a href="#">Ether 1:81</a> Behold this body, which ye now behold, is the body of <b>my spirit</b>; and man have I created after the body of my spirit; <b>and even as I appear unto thee to be in the spirit, will I appear unto my people in the flesh.</b></p> <p><a href="#">2 Nephi 11:21</a> But, behold, they shall have wars, and rumors of wars; and when the day cometh that the Only Begotten of <b>the Father</b>, yea, <b>even the Father of heaven and of earth, shall manifest himself unto them in the flesh, behold, they will reject him</b>, because of their iniquities, and the hardness of their hearts, and the stiffness of their necks.</p> <p><a href="#">Jacob 3:5</a> Behold, <b>they believed in Christ, and worshipped the Father</b> in his name; and also, we worship <b>the Father</b> in his name.</p> <p><a href="#">Mosiah 1:102</a> And <b>he shall be called Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the Father of heaven and earth, the Creator of all things</b>, from the beginning; and his mother shall be called Mary.</p> <p><a href="#">Mosiah 5:44</a> And <b>because he said unto them, that Christ was the God, the Father of all things, and said that he should take upon him the image of man</b>, and it should be the image after which man was created in the beginning;</p> <p><a href="#">Helaman 5:66</a> And also that ye might <b>know of the coming of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the Father of heaven, and of earth, the Creator of all things, from the beginning</b>; and that ye might know of the signs of his coming, to the intent that ye might believe on his name.</p> <p><a href="#">Helaman 5:130</a> If so, <b>and he be the Son of God, the Father of heaven and of earth</b>, as it has been spoken, why will he not shew himself unto us, as well as unto them who shall be at Jerusalem?</p>

[John 14:9](#) Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen **the Father**; and how sayest thou then, Show us **the Father**?

[1 John 5:7](#) For there are three that bear record in heaven, **the Father**, the Word, and the Holy Ghost; and these three are one.

[3 Nephi 13:22](#) Yea, your joy shall be full, even as the Father hath given me fullness of joy; and ye shall be even as I am, **and I am even as the Father; and the Father and I are one;**

[Mormon 2:46](#) They were once a delightsome people, and **they had Christ for their Shepherd; yea, they were led even by God, the Father.**

[Mormon 4:71](#) Behold, he created Adam; and by Adam came the fall of man. And **because of the fall of man, came Jesus Christ, even the Father and the Son; and because of Jesus Christ** came the redemption of man.

[Ether 1:77](#) Behold, I am he who was prepared from the foundation of the world to redeem my people. **Behold, I am Jesus Christ. I am the Father and the Son.**

[Ether 1:101](#) And in that day that they shall exercise faith in me, saith the Lord, even as the Brother of Jared did, that they may become sanctified in me, then will I manifest unto them the things which the Brother of Jared saw, even to the unfolding unto them all my revelations, **saith Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the Father of the heavens and of the earth, and all things that in them are.**

<p><b>The Bible Calls God <u>'The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.'</u></b></p>	<p><b>The Book of Mormon shares that Jesus Christ is <u>The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob</u></b></p>
<p><b><u>Exodus 2:24</u></b> And God heard their groaning, and <b>God remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob.</b></p> <p><b><u>Exodus 3:6</u></b> Moreover he said, <b>I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.</b> And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.</p> <p><b><u>Exodus 4:5</u></b> That <b>they may believe that the Lord God of their fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath appeared unto thee.</b></p> <p><b><u>Exodus 6:3</u></b> And <b>I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob.</b> I am the Lord God Almighty; the Lord JEHOVAH. And was not my name known unto them?</p> <p><b><u>Acts 3:13</u></b> <b>The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus;</b> whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go.</p> <p><b><u>Acts 7:32</u></b> Saying, <b>I am the God of thy fathers, the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.</b> Then Moses trembled, and durst not behold.</p>	<p><b><u>1 Nephi 5:240</u></b> Yea, <b>the God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, yieldeth himself according to words of the angel, as a man, into the hands of wicked men, to be lifted up</b> according to the words of Zenock,</p> <p><b><u>Mormon 4:70</u></b> But behold, I will shew unto you a God of miracles, even <b>the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob; and it is that same God who created the heavens and the earth, and all things that in them are.</b></p>

<p><b>The Bible Calls God <u>'The Creator.'</u></b></p>	<p><b>The Book of Mormon shares that Jesus Christ is <u>The Creator</u></b></p>
<p><b><u>The Creator?</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Isaiah 40:28</u></b> Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the Lord, the <b>Creator of the ends of the earth,</b> fainteth not, neither is weary? there is no searching of his understanding.</p> <p><b><u>Matthew 23:6</u></b> And call no one your creator upon the earth, or your heavenly Father; <b>for one is your creator and heavenly Father, even he who is in heaven</b></p>	<p><b><u>2 Nephi 6:10</u></b> For it behooveth the great Creator that he suffereth himself to become subject <b>unto man in the flesh, and die for all men,</b> that all men might become subject unto him.</p> <p><b><u>Mosiah 1:102</u></b> And he shall be called <b>Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the Father of heaven and earth, the Creator of all things,</b> from the beginning; and his mother shall be called Mary.</p> <p><b><u>Helaman 5:66</u></b> And also that ye might know of <b>the coming of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the Father of heaven, and of earth, the Creator of all things,</b> from the beginning; and that ye might know of the signs of his coming, <b>to the intent that ye might believe on his name.</b></p>

<p>The Bible Calls God '<b><u>The Almighty.</u></b>'</p>	<p>The Bible shares that Jesus Christ is <b><u>The Mighty God, the Everlasting Father</u></b></p>
<p><b><u>Genesis 1:2</u></b> I am the Beginning and the End; <b>the Almighty</b> God.</p> <p><b><u>Genesis 7:74</u></b> But before that day, he saw great tribulation among the wicked; and he also saw the sea, that it was troubled, and men's hearts failing them, looking forth with fear for the judgment of <b>the Almighty</b> God, which should come upon the wicked.</p> <p><b><u>Genesis 17:1</u></b> And when Abram was ninety and nine years old, the Lord appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I, <b>the Almighty</b> God, give unto thee a commandment; that thou shalt walk uprightly before me, and be perfect.</p>	<p><b><u>Isaiah 9:6</u></b> For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder; and <b>his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.</b></p>

**The Lord Omnipotent?**

<p>The Bible Calls God '<b><u>The Lord Omnipotent.</u></b>'</p>	<p>The Book of Mormon shares that Jesus Christ is <b><u>The Lord Omnipotent</u></b></p>
<p><b><u>Revelation 19:6</u></b> And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia; for the Lord God <b>omnipotent</b> reigneth.</p>	<p><b><u>Mosiah 1:97</u></b> For behold, the time cometh, and is not far distant, that with power, the Lord <b>Omnipotent</b> who reigneth, who was, and is from all eternity to all eternity, <b>shall come down from heaven, among the children of men, and shall dwell in a tabernacle of clay,</b></p> <p><b><u>Mosiah 1:116</u></b> And moreover, I say unto you, that there shall be no other name given, nor any other way nor means whereby salvation can come unto the children of men, only in and through <b>the name of Christ, the Lord Omnipotent....<u>118</u></b> But men drink damnation to their own souls, except they humble themselves, and become as little children, and believe that salvation was, and is, and is to come, in and <b>through the atoning blood of Christ, the Lord Omnipotent:</b></p> <p><b><u>Mosiah 3:3</u></b> And also, we know of their surety and truth, because of <b>the Spirit of the Lord Omnipotent,</b> which has wrought a mighty change in us, or in our hearts, that we have no more disposition to do evil, but to do good continually.</p> <p><b><u>Mosiah 3:21</u></b> Therefore, I would that ye should be steadfast and immovable, always abounding in good works, <b>that Christ, the Lord God Omnipotent, may seal you his,</b> that you may be brought to heaven, that ye may have everlasting salvation and eternal life, through the wisdom, and power, and justice, and mercy of him, who created all things, in heaven and in earth, who is God above all. (Original Text of of the Book of Mormon as found in the RCE version)</p> <p><a href="#">Alma 8:93</a> Now Zeezrom saith again unto him, Is the Son of God the very <b>eternal Father</b>?</p> <p><a href="#">Alma 8:94</a> And Amulek said unto him, Yea, he is the very <b>eternal Father</b> of heaven and of earth, and all things which in them is;</p>

### Eternal God?

The Bible Calls God 'The Eternal God.'	The Book of Mormon shares that Jesus Christ is 'The Eternal God.'
<p><a href="#">Deuteronomy 33:27</a> The <b>eternal God</b> is thy refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms; and he shall thrust out the enemy from before thee; and shall say, Destroy them.</p>	<p><a href="#">Title Page 1:7</a> and also to the convincing of the Jew and Gentile that Jesus is the Christ, the <b>Eternal God</b>, manifesting himself unto all nations.</p> <p><a href="#">2 Nephi 11:78</a> And as I spake concerning the convincing of the Jews, that Jesus is the very Christ, it must needs be that the Gentiles be convinced also, that Jesus is the Christ, the <b>Eternal God</b>; and that he manifesteth himself unto all those who believe in him, by the power of the Holy Ghost;</p> <p><a href="#">2 Nephi 6:20</a> For behold, if the flesh should rise no more, our spirits must become subject to that angel who fell from before the presence of the <b>eternal God</b>, and became the devil, to rise no more.</p> <p><a href="#">Alma 8:104</a> And shall be brought and be arraigned before the bar of Christ the Son, and God the Father, and the Holy Spirit, which is one <b>eternal God</b>, to be judged according to their works, whether they be good or whether they be evil.</p>

## I AM

<p>In the Bible, God called himself 'I Am.' This term was so revered among Jews, that no one in Israel could refer to himself as "I AM."</p>	<p>When Jesus said 'I AM' the Jews tried to stone him, because it broke their laws. But why did Jesus say this? Because he was God.</p>
<p><a href="#">Exodus 3:14</a> And God said unto Moses, <b>I AM THAT I AM</b>; and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.</p>	<p><a href="#">John 8:58</a> Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before <b>Abraham</b> was, <b>I am</b>.</p>

## The Holy Ghost?

<p>The Bible implies that the Holy Ghost is a 'separate' being.</p>	<p>The Book of Mormon shares that the Holy Ghost is the Spirit of God, When God takes on flesh as a man, God's is the spirit within Jesus. Jesus said 'I will come to you'</p>
<p><a href="#">John 14:26</a> But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom <b>the Father</b> will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.</p> <p><a href="#">John 15:26</a> But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from <b>the Father</b>, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from <b>the Father</b>, he shall testify of me;</p>	<p><a href="#">John 14:18</a> I will not leave you comfortless; <b>I will come</b> to you.</p> <p><a href="#">Ether 1:81</a> Behold this body, which ye now behold, is the <b>body of my spirit</b>; and man have I created after the <b>body of my spirit</b>; and even as I appear unto thee to be in the spirit, will I appear unto my people in the flesh.</p>

<p><a href="#">Genesis 7:59</a> And the Lord said, Blessed is he through whose seed Messiah shall come; for he saith, I am Messiah, the King of Zion, <b>the Rock</b> of heaven, which is broad as eternity; and whoso cometh in at the gate, and climbeth up by me shall never fall.</p>	<p><a href="#">Helaman 2:74</a> And now my sons, remember, remember that it is upon <b>the rock</b> of our Redeemer, who is Christ, the Son of God, that ye must build your foundation, that when the devil shall send forth his mighty winds; yea, his shafts in the whirlwind;</p>

<p><a href="#">Revelation 1:8</a> For he saith, I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, the Lord, who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty.</p> <p><a href="#">Revelation 1:11</a> Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last; and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.</p> <p><a href="#">Revelation 21:6</a> And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. ### If Jesus was the Father, why would he pray 'to himself?'

The Book of Mormon explains Jesus demonstrated the obedience we (sinful humans) are to follow. We must pray to survive the spiritual battles of this world. Even though he was holy, he had to pray as well, as do all humans.

The same is true of Jesus' baptism. He likely didn't require water baptism, yet he was baptized to show us the way.

**[2 Nephi 13:7](#) And now, if the Lamb of God, he being holy, should have need to be baptized by water to fulfill all righteousness, O then, how much more need have we, being unholy, to be baptized, yea, even by water.**
