The Result of Obedience.....Prosperity

Remember Moses and the Serpent on the Pole?

All they had to do was look at it to be healed, but many would not. It seemed to easy.

Looking to the serpent was a type for Looking to Christ. It is easy by design....but you have to do it.

- The Change ONLY Happens when the Holy Ghost Baptizes You. You Can NOT do this on your own.
- Covenant begins with Faith in the Blood of Jesus who died to overcome our eternal death, so mercy could overpower justice.
- 3. Repentance means to desire change, from the old man to the new. Come to God in sincerity to make a covenant with him. Do no take his name upon you (i.e. make a covenant) in vain.
- 4. You covenant will take you on a journey. It will last your whole life. The journey will not be easy, but God promises to be with you every step of the way.

- Baptism by water makes your covenant real. It symbolizes both your new life and rebirth.
- 6. Baptism by the Holy Ghost gives you that portion of God's Spirit which brings you to change.
- 7. Call Unto God, asking for the change of Heart. He will respond.
- 8. Walk in new life in Christ, Endure the temptations of Satan to the end.
