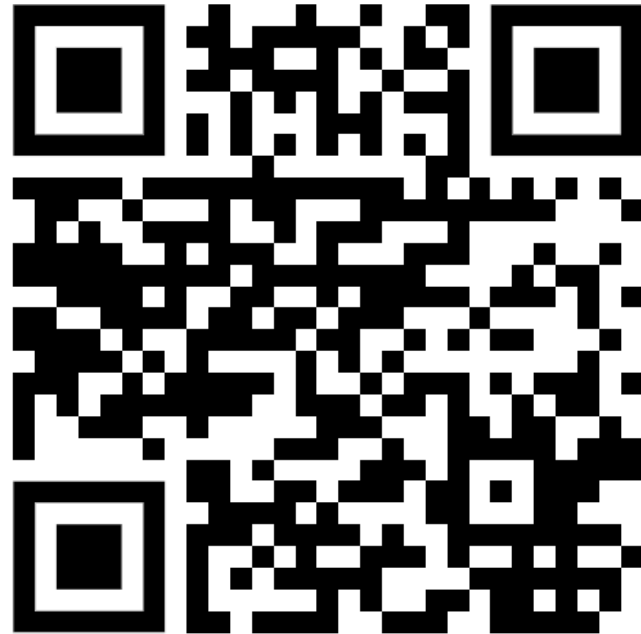

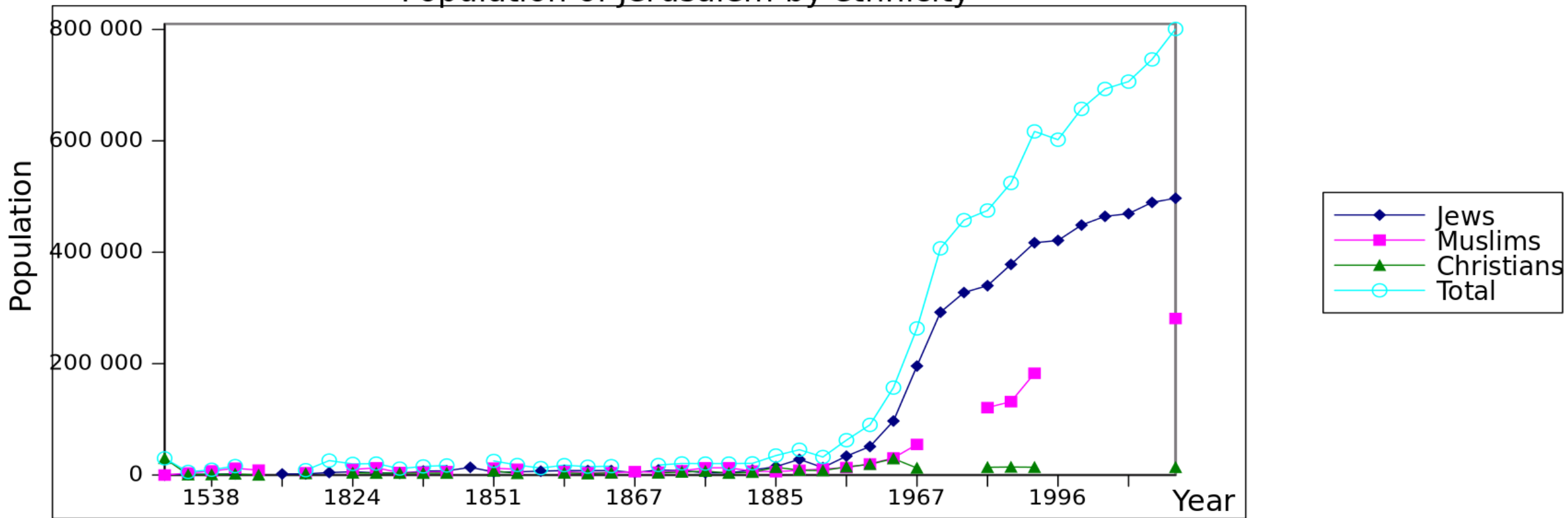
A Significant

Therefore I write unto you, Gentiles,
and also unto you, house of Israel,
when the work shall commence,
that ye shall be about to prepare
to return to the land of your inheritance;

-Mormon 1:82

The initial Gathering to Israel,
it is the quiet fulfilling of prophecy.

It is beginning.

Question: what has to happen to go from quiet gathering to world-wide event?

‘Kings shut their mouths’ at what they will see, (3 Nephi 9:44) or,

‘the Lord makes bare his arm before the nations’? (3 Nephi 9:73)

Answer: the same requirement since the beginning of time.

The World must know who and testify of who Jesus is.

QUESTION...When Does Zion Come?:

Genesis 9:21

And the bow shall be in the cloud;
and I will look upon it,
that I may remember the everlasting covenant, which I made unto thy
father Enoch;
that, **when men** should keep all my commandments,
Zion should again come on the earth,
the city of Enoch which I have caught up unto myself.

Zion is when...

J.J. Cornish, for example, wrote in 1919 of the problem with saints being deceived by personal feelings about the Kingdom's return, which discounted facts regarding the scriptures being fulfilled in that regard.

'...I was greatly surprised to hear that one minister said in his discourse, during Conference last April 1918 (while many of the hearers assented to the same), that "If Jesus does not come any time between now and 1930, then this thing is a fizzle, and we may as well throw the Books in the fire...."

Zion is when...

In a social meeting (in 1918), one stated among other things,

“I would not be surprised to see Christ come any minute.”

J.J Cornish’s response: ‘This cannot be. The Savior cannot come until the Scriptures are fulfilled which He declares must be fulfilled before He comes.’

(The Last Generation, J.J. Cornish, March 1, 1919)

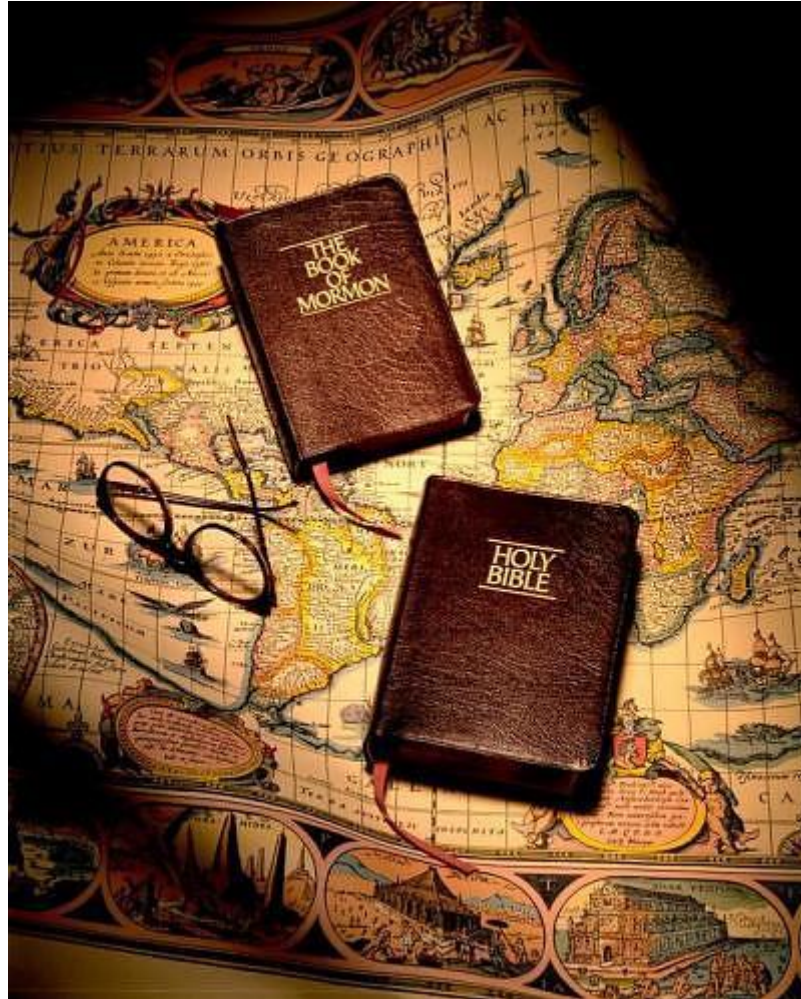


The Covenants contain Information like this flight panel

Every part of the covenants has information
DESCRIBING THE JOURNEY TO THE KINGDOM.



To Understand Covenants, must understand what ALL of them are saying.



The Instruments are Reliable, they rarely malfunction.

The number one source of aviation incidents is: Pilot error.



The Covenants and Prophecies...

Like a 1000-piece Puzzle, and we have half the pieces.

Can't always know where every piece fits until all pieces are in place.

But the parts we do have, if correctly fitted, provide a semblance of the final picture.

Consider this about Prophecy

- **Don't ever assume we have the whole picture with prophecy. We have some of the picture.**
- **Some prophets saw pieces, some saw all but were allowed to write little.**

False Paradigms based on Oral Traditions

Zion is when...

The Covenants Concerning Zion are Fulfilled.

Some of What the Covenants Foretell

- Israel returns to Jesus
- Truth is established among the Gentiles
- Times of Gentiles to Be Fulfilled
- Domination (of Jews) by Gentiles ends
- Josephs Remnant are scattered/gatherd (on this land)
- The 12 Tribes of Israel are regathered
- Gentiles share in Israel's Inheritance
- An earthly New Jerusalem will be built on this Land
- The Old Jerusalem becomes re-established as a Holy City
- Covenant People are restored to their (rightful) lands and knowledge of Jesus
- Good overcomes Evil; the great and abominable church is overcome
- Righteous Life on This Earth where all know Jesus and keep His commandments
- A New Heaven and New Earth are created
- Zion from Heaven Returns
- God dwells with Man.

- Moses

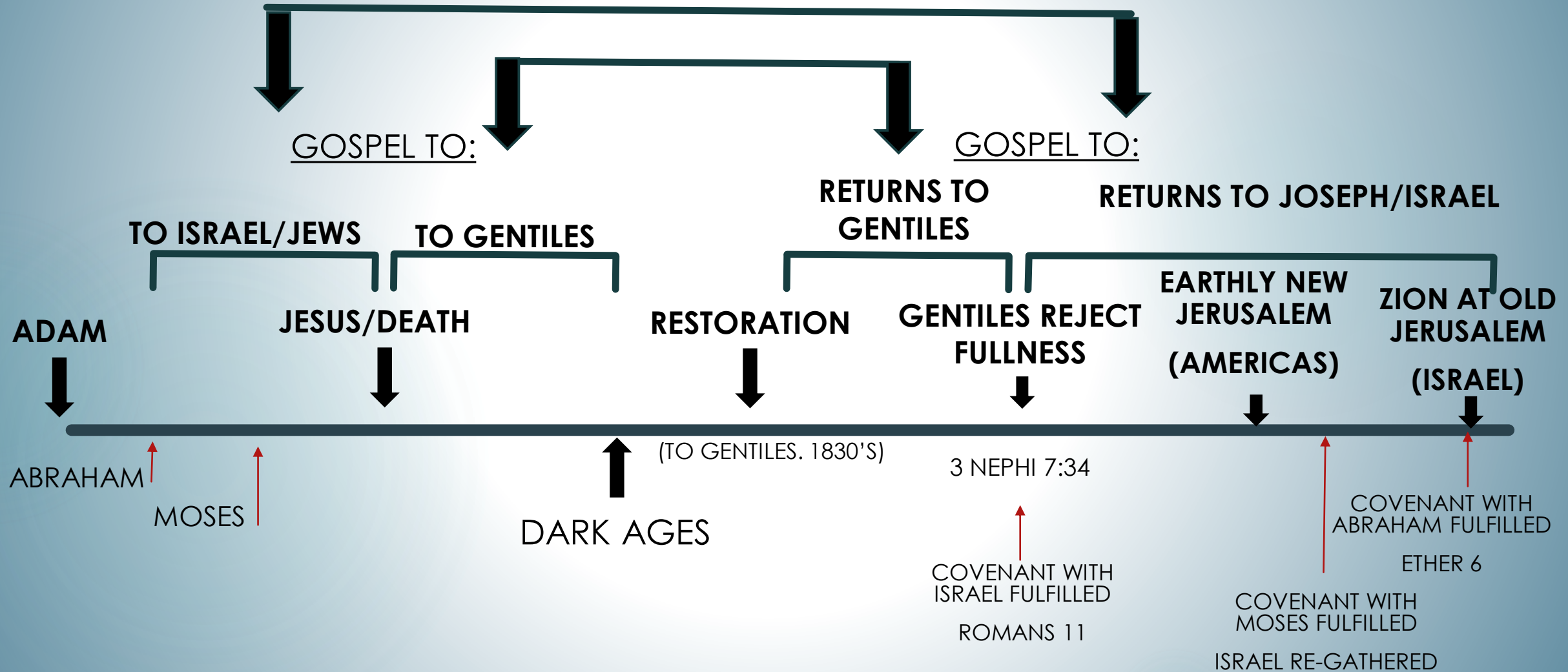

Abraham

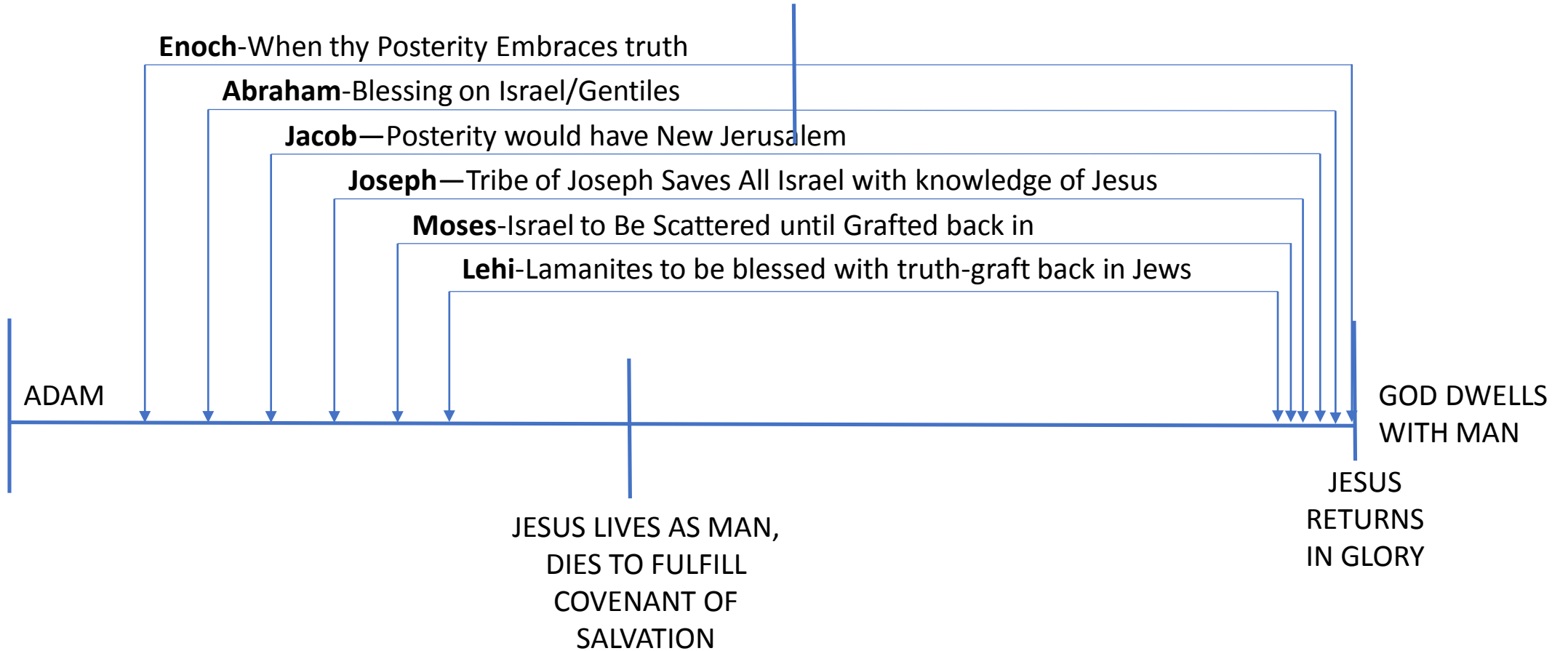
To The one who had no children
