
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
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

Abinadi's words....

Mosiah 8:5 "And moreover, I say unto you that salvation doth not come by the law alone;

And were it not for the atonement which God Himself shall make for the sins and iniquities of His people, that they must unavoidably perish, notwithstanding the law of Moses.

Mosiah 8:13 Have they not said that God Himself should come down among the children of men and take upon Him the form of man and go forth in mighty power upon the face of the earth?

Jews today already embrace, believe, teach Abinadi's words....

After reading Isaiah 53.....states:

Mosiah 8:28 And now Abinadi saith unto them:

I would that ye should understand that God Himself shall come down among the children of men and shall redeem His people; 29 And because He dwelleth in flesh, He shall be called the Son of God;
