- **2 Nephi 12:77** For behold I say unto you, As many of the **Gentiles** as will **repent** are the covenant people of the Lord; And as many of the Jews as will not **repent** shall be cast off;
- 3 Nephi 7:38 'But if the **Gentiles** will **repent** and return unto Me, ' saith the Father, 'Behold, they shall be numbered among My people, O house of Israel;
- <u>3 Nephi 9:56</u> "'And it shall come to pass, ' saith the Father, 'that the sword of My justice shalt hang over them at that day; And except they **repent**, it shall fall upon them, ' saith the Father, 'yea, even upon all the nations of the **Gentiles**.'

- Today we think of Mind as Reasoning and Control;
- But the Heart is Emotion.

- But To Scripture Writers The Heart was not emotion.
- The Heart was your thoughts, your life, your will, your intentions. Sin originates in the heart. The Heart defined your purpose.

A Broken Heart isn't sad. The Will is broken.

The Book of Mormon

- Speaks directly about the Heart.
- It teaches the Heart that must change.

- New Testament presents Christianity as a Checklist.
- Book of Mormon presents Christianity as a CHANGE.

Sin vs Willful Rebellion

Sin can be in ignorance.

KB mentions borrowing and not returning.

Not true of Willful Rebellion.

- even as though He had already come among them.

The Jews of Nephi's Days.....

15 And as one generation hath been destroyed among the Jews because of iniquity, Even so have they been destroyed from generation to generation according to their iniquities;

16 And never hath any of them been destroyed, save it were foretold them by the prophets of the Lord;

2 Nephi 11:15-16— SYNONOMOUS PARALLELISM

(A) And as <u>one generation</u> hath <u>been destroyed</u>
<u>among the Jews</u> because of iniquity,
(B) Even so have they been <u>destroyed from</u>
<u>generation to generation</u> according to their iniquities;

17 Wherefore, it hath been told them concerning the destruction which should come upon them immediately after my father left Jerusalem;

18 Nevertheless, they hardened their hearts and, according to my prophecy, they have been destroyed, save it be those which are carried away captive into Babylon.

11 "And since that they have been led away, these things have been prophesied concerning them,



Historically...

<u>Deuteronomy 29:4</u> - Yet the Lord has not given you a heart to understand or eyes to see or ears to hear, to this very day.

What does it mean to harden your heart?

1. You are blinded by the mists of darkness

1 Nephi 3:125 And the mists of darkness are the temptations of the devil which blindeth the eyes and hardeneth the hearts of the children of men, And leadeth them away into broad roads, that they perish and are lost.

2. You don't know what the Lord is doing for you.

Mormon 1:66 And I did cry unto this people, but it was in vain;

And they did not realize that it was the Lord that had spared them and granted unto them a chance for repentance;

67 And behold, they did harden their hearts against the Lord their God.

3. You then Can Not Understand

Mosiah 11:107 And now because of their unbelief, they could not understand the word of God.

And their hearts were hardened;

4. God's spirit has no place in you.

2 Nephi 15:2 But behold, there are many that harden their hearts against the Holy Spirit, that it hath no place in them; Wherefore, they cast many things away which are written and esteem them as things of naught.

Samuel The Lamanite Preaches...to the NEPHITES

Samuel Preaching to Nephites is as if an ISIS soldier were converted to Jesus, then comes back to Independence to tell the Restorationists about Christ...

Helaman 5:40

O ye wicked and ye perverse generation. Ye hardened and ye stiff-necked people!

How long will ye suppose that the Lord will suffer you? Yea, how long will ye suffer yourselves to be led by foolish and blind guides? Yea, how long will ye choose darkness rather than light?

A Note on Parallelisms.....

Have seen A/B Parallelism, where the second line expands the first. Goes along with Synonymous Parallelism, where information is increasingly added.

A Few More types:

Strophic Parallelism: Repeated statements

Antithetical Parallelism: Opposite or conflicting statements

Anadiplosis Parallelism: End of line matches beginning of next line

Helaman 5:40—NOTE THE PARALLELISMS

(A) O ye wicked and ye perverse generation.

(B) Ye hardened and ye stiff-necked people! (Synonymous)

How long will ye suppose that the Lord will suffer you?

(Strophic
Parallelism—
repeated first

lines)

(Anadiplosis Parallelism)

Yea, how long will ye suffer yourselves to be led by foolish and blind guides? (Synonymous Parallelism)

Yea, how long will ye choose darkness rather than light?

(Opposite = <u>Antithetical</u> Parallelism)

What Happens if <u>Hardness of Heart</u> is Unchecked? Alma 16:

233 For behold, if ye have procrastinated the day of your repentance, even until death, Behold, ye have become subjected to the spirit of the devil, And he doth seal you his;

234 Therefore, the Spirit of the Lord hath withdrawn from you and hath no place in you, And the devil hath all power over you;

And this is the final state of the wicked.

We saw their rise and fall.....why????

Helaman 2:162 And thus we see that the Spirit of the Lord began to withdraw from the Nephites because of the wickedness and the hardness of their hearts.

What was going on with the Nephites???

Helaman 2:59 And they saw they had become weak like unto their brethren the Lamanites,

And that the Spirit of the Lord did no more preserve them.

Yea, it had withdrawn from them because the Spirit of the Lord doth not dwell in unholy temples;

The Process

Helaman 5

10 Therefore, thus saith the Lord: 'Because of the hardness of the hearts of the people of the Nephites, except they repent I will take away My word from them, And I will withdraw My Spirit from them, And I will suffer them no longer, And I will turn the hearts of their brethren against them.

(Anidiplosis)

The WARNINGs to the GENTILES... 1 Nephi 3

- 215 A work which shall be everlasting, either on the one hand or on the other,
- 216 Either to the convincing of them unto peace and life eternal, Or unto the deliverance of them to the hardness of their hearts and the blindness of their minds,
 - Unto their being brought down into captivity.
 - And also unto destruction, both temporally and spiritually, according to the captivity of the devil of which I have spoken.

Similar to Israel.

We have seen the examples.

Convinced of truth or delivered to the Devil.

Being brought down to Captivity.

Temporal and Spiritual Destruction.

For rejecting who?

The WARNINGs to the GENTILES...

3 Nephi 9:66 "Nevertheless, when they shall have received the fullness of My gospel, then <u>if they shall harden their hearts against Me</u>, I will return their iniquities upon their own heads, saith the Father;

3 Nephi 10:1 But if they will repent, and hearken unto My words, and harden not their hearts, I will establish My church among them; And they shall come in unto the covenant and be numbered among this, the remnant of Jacob, unto whom I have given this land for their inheritance, And they shall assist My people, the remnant of Jacob

Ether writes at End of Jaredite civilization...

Ether 3:96

Wherefore, O ye Gentiles,

it is wisdom in God that these things should be shown unto you,

that thereby ye may repent of your sins....

Our Call to Repentance.....

The Jews, Nephites, Lamanites and Gentiles ALL had our chance with the Word of Christ

AND...EVERY GROUP EVENTUALLY DID THE SAME THING.....

WE hardened our hearts against Christ, the Eternal Father.

Judgement happens at the PEAK of RIPENESS.....we apparently haven't peaked yet.

When are we fully RIPE?

Helaman 5:18 'But behold, the time cometh, 'saith the Lord, 'that when ye shall cast out the righteous from among you, Then shall ye be ripe for destruction;

Ether 1:32 And the fullness of His wrath cometh upon them when they are ripened in iniquity; For behold, this is a land which is choice above all other lands; Wherefore, he that doth possess it shall serve God or shall be swept off, For it is the everlasting decrees of God -

When are we fully RIPE?

Ether 1:41

.....for ye shall remember that My Spirit will not always strive with man;

Wherefore, if ye will sin until ye are fully ripe, ye shall be cut off from the presence of the Lord;

Ether 4:22 And thus the Lord did pour out His blessings upon this land, which was choice above all other lands; And He commanded that whoso should possess the land should possess it unto the Lord or they should be destroyed when they were ripened in iniquity; "For upon such, " saith the Lord, "I will pour out the fullness of My wrath."

The Solution...

1 Nephi 7:64 But behold, all nations, kindreds, tongues and people shall dwell safely in the Holy One of Israel, if it so be that they will repent.

Alma 9:55 Therefore, whosoever repenteth and hardeneth not his heart, he shall have claim on mercy through Mine Only Begotten Son unto a remission of their sins,
