















































Why share the story?

The Exodus—A Type and Shadow for Salvation

The Event	The Symbol
Blood of a Lamb on the Door Post, Egypt (first born dies) symbolizes the world that doesn't come to Christ	Faith in the Blood of Jesus Shed for Sin
Depart from The Grip of Pharoah	RepentanceDepart from Sin.
Pass Through the Red Sea	Baptism by Water.
Receive the <u>Law to Guide</u>	Baptism by Holy Ghost (to Guide)
Forty Years on Manna	Live your life, endure the opposition by the acting on the word of God EVERY DAY in your life.
<u>Cross Jordan</u>	Judgement (at Resurrection) Joshua takes across. Blood sprinkled on Mercy Seat— his blood atones for our sin
Arrive at the Promised Land	God's Kingdom

The Book of Mormon Teaches Baptism is

- Our part of the Covenant—we witness that what it symbolizes about life, death, the grave. In Exchange for Holy Ghost, Promise of eternal Life. Our end of the bargain when we press forward in word in spirit.
- The Part of the Narrow, Strait Entrance

2 Nephi 13:27

...the Question AND the ANSWER

The Question:

And now my beloved brethren, after that ye have got into this strait and narrow path, I would ask if all is done?

The answer:

Behold, I say unto you, Nay

- a perfect brightness of hope and
- a love of God and of all men.

THE BIGGEST MISUNDERSTOOD VERSE IN EVANGELICAL CHRISTIANITY

Ephesians 2:8-9

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: **Not of works**, lest any man should boast.

Ephesians 2:10

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

(THIS IS A HEBREW PARALLEL CONTRASTING THE OLD WORKS OF THE MOSAIC LAW WITH THE (NEW) WORKS OF CHRIST)
