The Risk: Isolating Single Elements

Restoration -- sometimes does this with 'baptism.'

Much of Gentile Christianity isolates

'FAITH' as only believing in your heart.

But disregards baptism in Water or Holy Ghost or Enduring.

This misses the larger understandings taught by Jesus/Apostles throughout the bible.



IT'S NOT A CHECK LIST

Each act is a choice of Humility.

They blend together as the fundamental force of your life.



Must Demonstrate Sincerity To Enter 'The Way'

Moroni 6:2

Behold, elders, priests and teachers were baptized;

And they were not baptized, save they brought forth **fruit** meet that they were worthy of it;

Neither did they receive any unto baptism,

save they came forth with a broken heart and a contrite spirit

and witnessed unto the church

that they truly repented of all their sins;

The Way—is not a single step. (i.e. water baptism)

Walking In the Way the culmination of ALL these choices resulting in your lifelong change.

From Your Covenant, He gives Holy Ghost and promise of Eternal Life.

This is why Communion is for those who have voluntarily come into The Way.

That is why it is mockery to partake without coming into the way first.



Meaning of 'The Way'-- Moroni 8:29

And **baptism** cometh by faith,

to answer the ends of the law unto all those which have a broken heart and a contrite spirit, And unto none else can the **ends of the law** be answered.

Wherefore, how great the importance to make these things known unto the inhabitants of the earth, That they may know that there is no flesh that can dwell **in the presence of God**, save it be through the merits and mercy and grace of the Holy Messiah,...

Wherefore, He is the firstfruits unto God, inasmuch as He shall make **intercession** for all the children of men;

Wherefore, they stand in the presence of Him,

For it must needs be that there is an opposition in all things;

If not so, my firstborn in the wilderness,

righteousness could not be brought to pass. neither wickedness. Neither holiness nor misery, neither good nor bad.

Wherefore, all things must needs be a compound in one.

Wherefore, if it should be one body, it must needs remain as dead - having no life neither death, nor corruption, nor incorruption, happiness, nor misery, neither sense, nor insensibility; Wherefore, it must needs have been created for a thing of naught.

- THAT IS THE GREAT OPPOSITION IN ALL THINGS. NOT A WARNING THAT THINGS CAN GO BAD; BUT THE HOPE THAT BECAUSE ALL WAS BAD, HE BECAME THE REMEDY FOR GOOD.

WHAT A SAVIOR! WILL YOU COME TO HIM, AND WALK IN THE WAY WITH HIM.

Gave him much more than those cans could be worth.

The savior comes to you offering salvation, something you don't have and never will on your own.

What Was the Message of the Day?

The Law of Moses was Fulfilled.

Paul, Apostles Teach:

THE LAW OF MOSES WAS FULFILLED IN CHRIST.

But the Book of Mormon is even more Clear:

Mosiah 1:110 'Yet the Lord God saw that His people were a stiff-necked people and He appointed unto them a law, even the law of Moses.

Mosiah 1:113 And yet they hardened their hearts and understood not that the law of Moses availeth nothing, except it were through the atonement of His blood.

Galatians 3:24

Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

But the Book of Mormon is even more Clear:

Mosiah 1:110-113 'Yet the Lord God saw that His people were a stiff-necked people and He appointed unto them a law, even the law of Moses.

- 111 'And many signs and wonders and types and shadows showed He unto them concerning His coming;
- 112 And also holy prophets spake unto them concerning His coming,
- 113 And yet they hardened their hearts and understood not that the law of Moses availeth nothing, except it were through the atonement of His blood.

2 Nephi 11:45-46

And notwithstanding we believe in Christ,

We keep the law of Moses and look forward with steadfastness unto Christ until the law shall be fulfilled,

For, for this end was the law given

Wherefore, the law hath become dead unto us, And we are made alive in Christ because of our faith;

Notice 'Direct' reference to the Law of Moses

Romans 3:20

So then, in context, what is this saying???

Romans 3:27

Where is **boasting then**? It is excluded.

By what law? of works?

Nay: but by the law of faith.

(This is just another comparison to the Law of Moses being done and all the energy formerly directed to following the Mosaic Law was now to be spent following 'The Faith' of Jesus.)

THIS IS NOT SIMPLY ISOLATING 'BELIEF' AS THE ONLY REQUIREMENT TO FOLLOW JESUS.

"Sola Fide"—Faith Alone, is a popular Protestant Saying.

Romans 3:

19 Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God.

20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin.

21 But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and

the prophets;

22 Even the righteousness of God which is by <u>faith of Jesus</u>
Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:

23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

24 Being <u>justified</u> freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his

blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

26 To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

Romans 7

1 Know ye not, brethren, (for I speak to them that know the law,) how that the law hath dominion over a man as long as he liveth?

2 For the woman which hath an husband is bound by the law to her husband so long as he liveth;

but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of her husband.

3 So then if, while her husband liveth, she be married to another man,

she shall be called an adulteress:

but if her husband be dead, she is free from that law; so that she is no adulteress, though she be married to another man.

4 Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ;

that ye should be married to another, even to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God. 5 For when we were in the flesh, the motions of sins, which were by the law, did work in our members to bring forth fruit unto death.

6 But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter.

Salvation Comes NOT through the Law of Moses

Romans 8:3

For what **the law could not do**, in that it was weak **through the flesh**,

God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin,

condemned sin in the flesh:

From Last Week—C.O.O.C

Romans 9:31 But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness.

Romans 9:32 Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone;

Romans 10:4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.

Galatians 2:19

For I through **the law** am dead to **the law**, that I might live unto God.

Galatians 2:21

I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.

What Does the Bible Teach

Hebrews 10:1 For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.

Stating that the Law of Moses could not bring perfection, no matter what.

If it Could, then Jesus died in vain per Galatians 2:21

Important to Understand....

The message of 'Faith' was never 'just accept Jesus in your heart' and you are in the way.

It was ALWAYS contrasted to the Mosaic Law. The 'Law of Works' being contrasted to 'The Law of Faith'—i.e. Faith in Hebrew means to be firm and steadfast. Literally Firm like a wall.

But ONCE WE REALIZE the BIBLE COMMANDED THE WORKS OF JESUS, THEN IT ALL MAKES SENSE

James 2:

23 And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.

24 Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only.

THE APOSTLES WERE ALL AGREED

Book of Mormon states The Word came out from Apostles IN PURITY

1 Nephi 3:165-166

And the angel of the Lord said unto me:

"Thou hast beheld that the book proceeded forth from the mouth of a Jew; And when it proceeded forth from the mouth of a Jew it contained the fullness of the gospel of the Lord, of whom the twelve apostles bore record, And they bore record according to the truth which is in the Lamb of God;

Wherefore, these things go forth from the Jews in purity unto the Gentiles, according to the truth which is in God.

BUT SOME OF THE WORD WAS CHANGED

Book of Mormon states The Word came out from Apostles IN PURITY

1 Nephi 3:167-168

And <u>after that they go forth by the hand of the twelve apostles of the Lamb from the Jews unto the Gentiles</u>, Behold, after this thou seest the formation of <u>that great and abominable church</u>, which is the most abominable of all other churches.

For behold, they have taken away from the gospel of the Lamb many parts which are plain and most precious,

And also many covenants of the Lord have they taken away;

There is no problem reconciling James and Paul

James 2

10 For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.

11 For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law.

There is no problem reconciling James and Paul

12 So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty.

What is 'Our Work?'

The Book of Mormon teaches:

Ultimately to acknowledge our own unworthiness and the all-worthiness of Jesus.

If that is the attitude within us, then everything else will flow out from it.

If so, then the outflow

- BUT ALL THOSE WHO WERE BAPTIZED BY THE SPIRIT SEEMED EVENTUALLY TO BE WATER BAPTIZED. And this was required to be 'complete.' WE SEE IT IN THE BOOK OF MORMON. Ammon's converted lamanites were spiritually changed, but waited to return to Zarahemla, then they were baptized.

1 Corinthians 1:17 For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel

(17) Not to baptize.--Preaching was eminently the work of the Apostles.

The deacons used to baptise (Acts 10:48). The mention of "the preaching of the glad tidings" affords an opportunity for the Apostle stating in vindication of himself why that, and not philosophy, was the subject of his preaching, "lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect." Such, and not inability or ignorance, was the grand cause of his simplicity.

(Also mention the word 'wait tables' was the word deacon. Phoebe was diakonos. Meant waiter.

Pulpit Commentary

Verse 17. - Sent me not to baptize, but; that is, according to Semitic idiom, "not so much to baptize, as" (Matthew 28:19).

St. Paul again "goes off" at this word, and dwells for eight verses on the character of his preaching. Not in wisdom of words; not, that is, in a philosophic and oratorical style. The simplicity of the style and teaching of the apostles awoke the sneers of philosophers like Celsus and Porphyry. The cross of Christ. The central doctrine of Christianity, the preaching of a crucified Redeemer. Should be made void. The rendering of the Authorized Version is too strong; the cross cannot "be made of none effect."

The word means "should be emptied" (comp. <u>1 Corinthians 9:15</u>; <u>2 Corinthians 9:3</u>; <u>Philippians 2:7</u>; <u>Romans 4:14</u>); made void of its special and independent power. The words, "the cross of Christ," form the emphatic end of the sentence in the Greek.

Commanded=Arranged to be baptized.

Totally misses the symbol of dying unto ourselves, new life in him.

(Acts 10:48) **And he commanded them . . .**—It would seem from this that St. Peter acted on the same general principle as St. Paul (1Corinthians 1:14-17), and left the actual administration of baptism to other hands than his own. Who administered it in this instance we are not told. Possibly there may have been an ecclesia already organised at Caesarea, as the result of Philip's work, and its elders or deacons, or Philip himself, may have acted under Peter's orders. If those who came with him from Joppa had so acted, it would probably we may believe, have been stated.

The mention of "the preaching of the glad tidings" affords an opportunity for the Apostle stating in vindication of himself why that, and not philosophy, was the subject of his preaching, "lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect."

Such, and not inability or ignorance, was the grand cause of his simplicity.
