My Irish Heritage... My dad's grandparents-Full blooded Irish



...Information from Ancestors is carried on DNA

DNA—at center of every cell.

DNA produces (by a code) all the molecules, cells, tissues, output of your body. A pattern locked in the code, usually unique to you, but passed on by your parents.

A strand of your father's DNA joined a strand of your mother's DNA, the two as one created you.



...Information from Ancestors is carried on DNA

We don't look the same because different combinations of your DNA exist in every sperm or egg cell.

Unless identical twins, the DNA will be different each time....

Could some parts of DNA be the same for all of us??





Differences in the remaining 0.1 percent hold important clues about the causes of diseases.




Study Suggested that knowledge

...DNA

Science assumed DNA was fixed, unchangable for your entire life.



DNA output is affected by even FOOD.....

<u>Science assumed DNA produced results that were fixed</u>, unchangeable for your entire life.

Epigenetics—realizes certain influences can modify how your genes (DNA) behaves.

FOOD: Food traditionally thought of as nutrition (only).

Science has learned FOOD to be information.

Your DNA can respond to food or toxins in your body to behave differently.

What comes in is INFORMATION that affects its behavior.

Can also change the DNA.

Adam and Eve and Theologians....

'Original Sin'—term coined by theologians about 400 AD.

This Term does NOT appear in any scripture.

BUT...because it's 'suggested' Many responses to this exist in 'Christianity'.....



Protestant Reformation

Martin Luther

"It is also taught among us that since the fall of Adam all men who are born according to the course of nature are conceived and born in sin. That is, all men are full of evil lust and inclinations from their mothers' wombs and are unable by nature to have true fear of God and true faith in God.

Moreover, this inborn sickness and hereditary sin is truly sin and condemns to the eternal wrath of God all those who are not born again through Baptism and the Holy Spirit.



Roman Catholicism

"original sin does not have the character of a personal fault in any of Adam's descendants"

The doctrine of original sin thus does not impute the sin of the father to his children, but merely states that they inherit from him a "human nature deprived of original holiness and justice", which is "transmitted by propagation to all mankind"

Catechism of the Catholic Church, (403), infants have baptized, though not guilty of any actual personal sin.

The sin that through baptism is remitted for them could only be original sin.

Baptism confers original sanctifying grace which erases original (Adam's) sin and any actual personal sin.



Seventh-day Adventism

The nature of the penalty for original sin, i.e., Adam's sin, is to be seen as literal, physical, temporal, or actual death – the opposite of life, i.e., the cessation of being.

God did not punish Adam by making him a sinner. That was Adam's own doing.

All die the first death because of Adam's sin regardless of their moral character – children included.[87]



Justin Martyr---1st century AD

In Justin's writings, there is no conception of original sin and the fault of sin lies at the hands of the individual who committed it.

"The Christ has suffered to be crucified for the race of men who, since Adam, were fallen to the power of death and were in the error of the serpent, each man committing evil by his own fault"

(Justin was Martyred for accusing Jews of removing scripture naming Jesus as the Redeemer of Israel)

Helaman 5:70 Yea, behold, this death bringeth to pass the resurrection and redeemeth all mankind from the first death - that spiritual death,

For all mankind - by the fall of Adam, being cut off from the presence of the Lord - are considered as dead, both as to things temporal and to things spiritual.

3. All Humanity Inherited the

CAPACITY to ACT on the KNOWLEDGE OF GOOD AND EVIL.

Alma 9:51

Wherefore, He gave commandments unto men, they having first transgressed the first commandments as to things which were temporal and becoming as gods, knowing good from evil.

Placing themselves in a state to act, or being placed in a state to act according to their wills and pleasures, whether to do evil or to do good.

And men are <u>instructed sufficiently</u>, that they **know good from evil**;

An age of accountability.

- Specific age NOT mentioned in the Book of Mormon, but Restoration Churches have other scripture identifying that to be 8 years old. (Genesis 17:11 ISV, DC 68:4a-b)
- Not when satan can fully tempt at this age, but suggests there is a point in child development where you begin to know right from wrong.
- The only expressions of infants are based on physical, cognitive and emotional changes so that spiritual can develop in balance. Character and Expressions of little children are NOT BASED ON SIN.



An age of accountability implied by the Book of Mormon.

Mosiah 1:122 And behold, when that time cometh, none shall be found blameless before God, except it be little children, Only through repentance and faith on the name of the Lord God Omnipotent.

Mosiah 4:2 And it came to pass that there was not one soul, except it were little children, but what had entered into the covenant and had taken upon them the name of Christ.



In fact, Children are the Example Jesus Gives that Adults must Spiritually Become.

Mosiah 1:118

But men drinketh damnation to their own souls,

except they humble themselves and become as little children,

...But by Teenage Years....

Children Are Sinners

(using Psalm 51 to justify, author states...)

...It does not matter how much our children adorably display our features, or how little knowledge they possess, they are prone to doing evil.

Babies are able to <u>masterfully manipulate their parents with</u> their cries (oddly enough right about the time dinner needs to get started).

Toddlers can throw selfish tantrums. No one has to teach a child how to do these things. In fact, quite the opposite occurs. Parents typically attempt to take the selfish nature of a child and modify that behavior to be more socially acceptable.

If children were inherently good from the womb, discipline would not be necessary.

Children are not inherently good and in need of socialization.

They are inherently sinners in need of a savior.





What does this mean? The **Natural Man** is an **ENEMY** TO GOD....

Mosiah 1:119

For the natural man is an enemy to God and has been from the fall of Adam, and will be forever and ever.



(In Context) 'Natural Man' is Contrasted with Children

Mosiah 1:118-120

But men drinketh damnation to their own souls,

except they humble themselves and become as little children,

And believeth that salvation was and is and is to come, in and through the atoning blood of Christ, the Lord Omnipotent.

For the natural man is an enemy to God

and has been from the fall of Adam, and will be forever and ever.

But if* he yieldeth to the enticings of the Holy Spirit and putteth off the natural man –

And he becometh a saint through the atonement of Christ the Lord, And becometh as a child - submissive, meek, humble, patient, full of love,

Willing to submit to all things which the Lord seeth fit to inflict upon him, even as a child doth submit to his father.

*Hebrew: 'but if' = 'unless'



(In Context) 'Natural Man' is Contrasted with Children (is Hebrew Parallel/Chiasm)

Perhaps 'hostile to' is the original Hebrew intent of 'Enemy' to God stated in the Book of Mormon (this is my opinion however, not fact)

In our state we are called 'enemies' to God, but perhaps this more accurately means we are 'hostile' to.

Our present state is 'Hostile to' or 'Contrary to God.'

God of course is not our enemy—like as military enemies plot each other's mutual destruction.



This incompatibility is NOT applied to Children

Or in other words...

The nature of CHILDREN is not HOSTILE to GOD.

Moroni 8:25 For behold that all little children are alive in Christ,

His death and resurrection was so we could ALL be 'compatible' with him again.

8 And the word of the Lord came to me by the power of the Holy Ghost, saying: 'Listen to the words of Christ your Redeemer, your Lord and your God;


9 Behold, I came into the world, not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance;

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




