The Type and Lesson of The Serpent

Numbers 21:5

5And the people spake against God and against Moses

Wherefore have ye brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? for there is <u>no bread</u>, <u>neither is there any water</u>;

and our soul loatheth this light bread..

Numbers 21:6

And the LORD sent fiery **serpent**s among the people, and they bit the people; and much people of Israel died.

Numbers 21:7

Therefore the people came to Moses, and said,

We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD,

- Take up the idea of **ELECTION**—This was from Deuteronomy to refer to ISRAEL.
- GENTILES HAVE HIGHJACKED THIS IDEA THINKING IT IS OF THEIR SALVATION.
- THE ELECTION WAS THE IDEA THAT GOD HAD A PURPOSE IN FULFILLING HIS COVENANTS THROUGH ISRAEL.
- YOU CAN NOT SEPARATE THE NEW TESTAMENT FROM THE OLD TESTAMENT.
- BUT THAT IS WHAT STEVE LAWSON DOES.

Summary

- God offers salvation to ALL who will come to him. NONE who come to him are restricted.
- He did not preselect certain ones only to salvation whether or not he knows who will come to him.
- THIS IS BECAUSE IF THERE IS AN OPPOSITION IN ALL THINGS AND THE POINT OF SALVATION IS OUR WILL/OUR HEART CHANGING, THERE CAN NOT BE A PREDISPOSED PLAN TO SAVE ONLY SOME OR LIKEWISE, GOD WOULD CEASE TO BE GOD.
- IF GOD CEASES TO BE GOD FOR BREAKING HIS RULES, THEN IMPLIED THE RULES ALSO HAVE TO BE JUST.
- WHAT IS THE POINT OF PREACHING A SALVATION TEACHING ONLY SOME CAN BE SAVED AND YOU DON'T KNOW WHO YOU ARE.
- BUT REALIZE, THIS IS ON PAR WITH TEACHING A SALVATION THAT YOU CAN NOT KNOW EITHER OF INFINITE LEVELS OF SALVATION. THIS IS WHY IT IS WRONG ON EVERY LEVEL

- THE POINT OF CHRIST IS THAT OUR SIN SEPARATES US FROM HIM. TO ALL WHO WILL COME TO HIM THE SIN MAY AND CAN BE REMOVED. HE HAS THE ANSWER. THE ONLY ANSWER.

Also Note...'From the Foundation of the World'

Applied too generally in New Testament Translations.

One website states should be 'since man was thrust out of heaven' That is 'The Fall of Man.'

What Does Book of Mormon say?

So 'Since the Foundation of the World' might not mean from before time began' but since man fell away from God.

The Book of Mormon couples 'Foundation of the world' and 'Fall of man' two different times in the Book of Mormon in near verses. Ties the concepts together.

The Fall of Man—term does not exist in English translations of the Bible.

work - Hebrew: Maaseh-an action (good or bad); product; transaction; business

Romans 9:20-23 - Who art thou that repliest against God? Shall the thing formed say to him that formed it, why hast thou made me thus? Hath not the potter the power over the clay of the same lump, to make one vessel unto honour and another unto dishonour — What if God willing to show his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much long suffering the vessels of wrath filted to destruction: And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he hath afore prepared unto glory.

fitted - Greek: katartizo - to complete thoroughly; fit; frame; arrange; prepare. Theyer says this word speaks of men whose souls God has so constituted that they cannot escape destruction; their mind is fixed that they frame themselves.

Men get angry to think that we serve a God that can do as it pleases him. They actually think that an almighty God thinks the way they think and that he could not possibly form-fit a vessel to hell merely to show his wrath and power. Paul said he does. Men have difficulty perceiving a God that predestinates men (Rom. 8:29) on whom he desires to show his grace (unmerited favor) and mercy, that he may shower them throughout etemity with the riches of his glory. We like to believe that we must give him permission; if he is to operate in our hearts and minds. The Lord said, "My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways. As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts (Isalah 55:8,9)". Our God is in the heavens: he hath done whatscever he hath pleased (Psalms 115:3). He doeth whatscever pleaseth him (Eccl 8:3). Thou, O Lord hast done as it pleased thee (Jonah 1:14). Whatsoever the Lord pleased, that did he in heaven, and earth, and in the seas, and in all deep places (Psalms 135:6). He does all his pleasure (Isa. 46:10; Isa. 44:24-28; Eph. 1:5,9; Philippians 2:13). It is Jesus that holds the keys to death and hell (Rev. 1:18), not Satan. God will intentionally cast these evil vessels of wrath into hell and lock them up for eternity because it is not his pleasure to draw them to him (John 6:44). This doctrine angers men, though it is taught throughout the pages of God's Holy Book, Men do not have a Biblical view of the living God when they think he is not in control of all things including the minds and hearts of all men. God is not only love to the vessels of mercy, but he is a consuming fire (Deut 4:24) upon the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction. We do not serve a God who is Superman that can only shake mountains, implode blackholes, and explode quasars. The God of the universe can harden and soften the hearts of men at will (Rom 9:18; Ezek. 38:26). He giveth not account of any of his matters (Job 33:13).

Lawson errors

What he calls the 'God side'

Being Born of God is being confused with 'being singled out or selected' by God.

The scripture 'BORN of GOD' means transformed, chosen of God, NOT that God predestined only some.
