I STAND AT THE DOOR AND KNOCK

2 Nephi 26:25 Behold, doth he cry unto any, saying: Depart from me? Behold, I say unto you, Nay; but he saith: Come unto me all ye ends of the earth, buy milk and honey, without money and without price.

26 Behold, hath he commanded any that they should depart out of the synagogues, or out of the houses of worship? Behold, I say unto you, Nay.

WHAT IS CALVINISM?

Key Beliefs:

Sovereignty of God:

Calvinism emphasizes God's ultimate authority and control over all things, including salvation.

Predestination:

The belief that God has chosen who will be saved before they are born, and nothing they do can change that decision.

• Salvation by Grace:

Salvation is a free gift from God, not earned through good works.

Authority of Scripture:

The Bible is considered the supreme authority for Christian faith and practice.

- Five Points of Calvinism (TULIP):
 - **Total Depravity:** Human beings are inherently sinful and unable to choose God without God's intervention.
 - **Unconditional Election:** God chooses individuals for salvation based on His own will, not on any foreseen merit or good works.
 - **Limited Atonement:** Jesus's sacrifice on the cross was specifically for the elect, those chosen for salvation.
 - **Irresistible Grace:** God's grace is effectively applied to those He has chosen, and they cannot resist it.
 - **Perseverance of the Saints:** Those who have been chosen for salvation will persevere in faith until the end of their lives.

Historical Context:

- Calvinism emerged during the Protestant Reformation in the 16th century, with John Calvin and his followers developing and expanding on his theological ideas.
- It influenced the development of Reformed churches, Presbyterianism, and other Protestant traditions.

CALVINISM AND THE BOOK OF MORMON ZORAMITES

Alma 31:14 Therefore, whosoever desired to worship must go forth and stand upon the top thereof, and stretch forth his hands towards heaven, and cry with a loud voice, saying:

15 Holy, holy God; we believe that thou art God, and we believe that thou art holy, and that thou wast a spirit, and that thou art a spirit, and that thou will be a spirit forever.

16 Holy God, we believe that thou hast separated us from our brethren; and we do not believe in the tradition of our brethren, which was handed down to them by the childishness of their fathers; but we believe that thou hast elected us to be thy holy children; and also thou hast made it known unto us that there shall be no Christ.

17 But thou art the same yesterday, today, and forever; and thou hast elected us that we shall be saved, whilst all around us are elected to be cast by thy wrath down to hell; for the which holiness, O God, we thank thee; and we also thank thee that thou hast elected us, that we may not be led away after the foolish traditions of our brethren, which doth bind them down to a belief of Christ, which doth lead their hearts to wander far from thee, our God.

18 And again we thank thee, O God, that we are a chosen and a holy people. Amen.

- 19 Now it came to pass that after Alma and his brethren and his sons had heard these prayers, they were astonished beyond all measure.
- 20 For behold, every man did go forth and offer up these same prayers.
- 24 Now when Alma saw this his heart was grieved; (RLDS Alma 16:90-100)

FREEDOM TO THINK AND CHOOSE

Alma 30:7-11 Now there was no law against a man's belief; for it was strictly contrary to the commands of God that there should be a law which should bring men on to unequal grounds.

- 8 For thus saith the scripture: Choose ye this day, whom ye will serve.
- 9 Now if a man desired to serve God, it was his privilege; or rather, if he believed in God it was his privilege to serve him; but if he did not believe in him there was no law to punish him.
- 10 But if he murdered he was punished unto death; and if he robbed he was also punished . . . Nevertheless, there was no law against a man's belief; therefore, a man was punished only for the crimes which he had done; therefore all men were on equal grounds. (RLDS Alma 16:8-12)
- **2 Nephi 2:27** Wherefore, men are free according to the flesh; and all things are given them which are expedient unto man. And they are free to **choose** liberty and eternal life, through the great Mediator of all men, or to **choose** captivity and death, according to the captivity and power of the devil; for he seeketh that all men might be miserable like unto himself.

2 Nephi 9:6 For as death hath passed upon all men, to fulfil the merciful plan of the great Creator, there must needs be a power of resurrection, and the resurrection must needs come unto man by reason of the fall; and the fall came by reason of

transgression; and because man became fallen they were cut off from the presence of the Lord.

(RCE: 2 Nephi 6:11)

<u>Alma 12:15</u> But this cannot be; we must come forth and stand before him in his glory, and in his power, and in his might, majesty, and dominion, and acknowledge to our everlasting shame that all his judgments are just; that he is just in all his works, and that he is merciful unto the children of men, and that he has all power to save every man that believeth on his name and bringeth forth fruit meet for repentance. (RCE: Alma 9:26)

Alma 12:24 And we see that death comes upon mankind, yea, the death which has been spoken of by Amulek, which is the temporal death; nevertheless there was a space granted unto man in which he might repent; therefore this life became a probationary state; a time to prepare to meet God; a time to prepare for that endless state which has been spoken of by us, which is after the resurrection of the dead. 36 And this I know, because the Lord hath said he dwelleth not in unholy temples, but in the hearts of the righteous doth he dwell; yea, and he has also said that the righteous shall sit down in his kingdom, to go no more out; but their garments should be made white through the blood of the Lamb.

37 And now, my beloved brethren, I desire that ye should remember these things, and that ye should work out your salvation with fear before God, and that ye should no more deny the coming of Christ; (RLDS **Alma 16:226-236**)

D&C 132 7, 19-21 **7** And verily I say unto you, that the <u>conditions</u> of this law are these: All covenants, contracts, bonds, obligations, <u>oaths</u>, <u>vows</u>, performances, <u>connections</u>, <u>associations</u>, or <u>expectations</u>, that are not made and entered into and <u>sealed</u> by the Holy Spirit of promise, of him who is <u>anointed</u>, both as well for time and for all eternity, and that too most holy, by <u>revelation</u> and commandment through the medium of mine anointed, whom I have appointed on the earth to hold this <u>power</u> (and I have appointed unto my servant Joseph to hold this <u>power</u> in the last days, and there is never but one on the earth at a time on whom this power and the <u>keys</u> of this priesthood are conferred), are of no efficacy, virtue, or force in and after the resurrection from the dead; for all contracts that are not made unto this end have an end when men are dead.

20 Then shall they be gods, because they have no end; therefore shall they be from everlasting to everlasting, because they continue; then shall they be above all, because all things are subject unto them. Then shall they be gods, because they have all power, and the angels are subject unto them.

21 Verily, verily, I say unto you, except ye abide my <u>law</u> ye cannot attain to this glory.

- **Ether 8:13** And it came to pass that Akish gathered in unto the house of Jared all his kinsfolk, and said unto them: Will ye swear unto me that ye will be faithful unto me in the thing which I shall desire of you?
- **14** And it came to pass that they all sware unto him, by the God of heaven, and also by the heavens, and also by the earth, and by their heads, that whoso should vary from the assistance which Akish desired should lose his head; and whoso should divulge whatsoever thing Akish made known unto them, the same should lose his life.

Letter from Thomas Jefferson to John Adams

MONTICELLO, November 13, 1818.

The public papers, my dear friend, announce the fatal event of which your letter of October the 20th had given me ominous foreboding. Tried myself in the school of affliction, by the loss of every form of connection which can rive the human heart, I know well, and feel what you have lost, what you have suffered, are suffering, and have yet to endure. The same trials have taught me that for ills so immeasurable, time and silence are the only medicine. I will not, therefore, by useless condolences, open afresh the sluices of your grief, nor, although mingling sincerely my tears with yours, will I say a word more where words are vain, but that it is of some comfort to us both, that the term is not very distant, at which we are to deposit in the same cerement, our sorrows and suffering bodies, and to ascend in essence to an ecstatic meeting with the friends we have loved and lost, and whom we shall still love and never lose again. God bless you and support you under your heavy affliction.

Letter from John Adams to Thomas Jefferson

Dear Sir

Your Letter of Nov. 13 gave me great delight not only by the divine consolation it afforded me under my great affliction: but as it gave me full proof of your restoration to health.

While you live, I seem to have a bank at Montecello on which I can draw for a letter of friendship and entertainment when I please.

I know not how to prove physically that we shall meet and know each other in a future state; nor does revelation, as I can find give us any positive assurance of such a felicity. My reasons for believing it, as I do, most undoubtingly, are all moral and divine.

I believe in God and in his wisdom and benevolence: and I cannot conceive that such a being could make such a species as the human merely to live and die on this earth. If I did not believe a future state I should believe in no God. This Universe; this all; this $\tau o \pi \alpha v$; would appear with all its swelling pomp, a boyish fire work. And if there be a future state why should the Almighty dissolve forever all the tender ties which unite us so delightfully in this world and forbid us to see each other in the next?

<u>2 Nephi 33:7</u> I have charity for my people, and great faith in Christ that I shall meet many souls spotless at his judgment-seat.
(RCE: 2 Nephi 15:8)

<u>Jacob 6:13</u> Finally, I bid you farewell, until I shall meet you before the pleasing bar of God, which bar striketh the wicked with awful dread and fear. Amen.

Excerpts from my response:

"Thank you so very much for your kind email below . . . I am touched at the amount of time you apparently spent in drafting your sincere caring message to me. Based on the content of your email it appears that the rumor mill has been somewhat active regarding my and Annette's well thought out decision to have our names removed from membership in the LDS church (church).
