"Zion in Book of Mormon"

- 'Zion' exists 42 times in Book of Mormon
- Mostly occurs when quoted by Isaiah and requoted in Book of Mormon
- Process of Zion explained in Ether 6 (Ether 13) without using the word 'Zion.'

Jesus says:

<u>3 Nephi 9:86</u> (LDS: <u>3 Nephi 21:1</u>) And verily I say unto you, I give unto you a sign that ye may know the time when these things shall be about to take place, That I shall gather in from their long dispersion <u>My people, O house of Israel</u>, <u>And shall establish again among them</u> **My Zion**.

"Zion....in Doctrine and Covenants"

• 'Zion' exists <u>204 times in the RLDS Doctrine and Covenants</u>, but embellishes <u>Gentiles</u> gathering to build Zion, not <u>Joseph</u>. Even correlates Baptism for the Dead to be performed in Zion. Why?

DC 107:11c And after this time, your baptisms for the dead, by those who are scattered abroad, are not acceptable unto me, saith the Lord; for it is ordained that in Zion, and in her stakes, and in Jerusalem, those places which I have appointed for refuge, shall be the places for your baptisms for your dead.???

1 And now I, Moroni, proceed to finish my record concerning the destruction of the people of which I have been writing.

2 For behold, they rejected all the words of Ether; For he truly told them of all things from the beginning of man, And how that after the waters had receded from off the face of this land, it became a choice land above all other lands, a chosen land of the Lord –

3 Wherefore, the Lord would have that all men should serve Him which dwelt upon the face thereof - And that it was the place of the New Jerusalem, which should come down out of heaven, and the holy sanctuary of the Lord.

4 Behold, Ether saw the days of Christ; And he spake concerning a New Jerusalem upon this land - And he spake also concerning the house of Israel and the Jerusalem from whence Lehi should come - After that it should be destroyed, it should be built up again a holy city unto the Lord;

5 Wherefore, it could not be a New Jerusalem, for it had been in a time of old, But it should be built up again and become a holy city of the Lord; And it should be built up unto the house of Israel –

6 And that a New Jerusalem should be built up upon this land unto the remnant of the seed of Joseph, for the which things there has been a type - For as Joseph brought his father down into the Land of Egypt, even so he died there;

7 Wherefore, the Lord brought a remnant of the seed of Joseph out of the Land of Jerusalem, That He might be merciful unto the seed of Joseph, that they should perish not, Even as He was merciful unto the father of Joseph, that he should perish not.

8 Wherefore, the remnant of the house of Joseph shall be built up upon this land, And it shall be a land of their inheritance; And they shall build up a holy city unto the Lord, like unto the Jerusalem of old; And they shall no more be confounded until the end come when the earth shall pass away;

9 And there shall be a new heaven and a new earth; And they shall be like unto the old, save the old have passed away and all things have become new.

10 And then cometh the New Jerusalem; And blessed are they which dwell therein, For it is they whose garments are white through the blood of the Lamb; And they are they which are numbered among the remnant of the seed of Joseph which were of the house of Israel.

11 And then also cometh the Jerusalem of old and the inhabitants thereof; Blessed are they, for they have been washed in the blood of the Lamb;

12 And they are they which were scattered and gathered in from the four quarters of the earth and from the North Countries, And are partakers of the fulfilling of the covenant which God made with their father Abraham.

Abraham Covenant



Abraham covenant claims only Heavenly New Jerusalem <u>returns</u> <u>after new earth.</u> <u>Emphasizes Israel's return</u> to Christ

<u>Explains BOTH Old and New</u> <u>Jerusalem built up</u> AND Both persist to New Heaven and Earth.

All This Causes Confusion Among the Saints Today.

- We get <u>Covenants</u> wrong
- <u>Holy City's</u> wrong
- <u>Who builds the Cities is wrong.</u>
- We even get the names wrong.
- We teach 1000 years...which is not according to other scripture. '1000 years' seems a product of assumptions by Biblical scribes

What the Early Saints Seemingly had wrong...

- Israel would return to Christ (call on God in the name of Jesus) BEFORE ZION. This is part of the Covenant with Abraham.
- The Gentiles were/are to take the original Gospel back to Israel. They had little success, although this is still being played out.

Incorrect Assumptions by Early Church...

- The Early Church would build 'Zion' in Independence in 1800's. <u>NO.</u>
- The New Jerusalem would be built, and old Jerusalem rebuilt, as Holy Cities unto the Lord by ISRAEL. Repentant Gentiles would assist, but not lead.

Incorrect Assumptions by Early Church...

• Remnant would return to Church in 1800's and acknowledge Priesthood.

NO.

- Joseph's remnant needed to call on Christ first.
- They wouldn't return to Christ until after scattering complete. Scattering to Native American reservations extended into the 1930s.

Incorrect Assumptions by Early Church...

• Early saints assumed Israel was right behind them gathering to Independence.

NO

- Jews must call on Jesus first.
- This wouldn't happen until gospel returns to them.
- And this doesn't happen until Gospel is taken from Gentiles and returns to house of Israel.

What the Early Saints Seemingly had wrong...

- Restoring the church....would likely be the simple church of the Nephites. That didn't happen, although elements of it exist.
- Instead, a church taking parts of Nephites, Israel and Gentiles came to pass. We call this 'the Restored' church, but it wasn't the restored Nephite church.

Instead, Gentiles receive 'new revelation' on Melchizedek Priesthood, Enoch, Enoch City, etc.

- These captivate the minds of the church.
- Restoration can think of little else, propelling the urgency with each generation.
- But no results.....ever.
- Gentiles have mixed traditions in with truth and are confounded by the traditions.
- <u>The truth about covenants, priesthood, the Holy City is explained in</u> <u>the Book of Mormon, not the Doctrine and Covenants.</u>
- This is the largest contradiction of all scripture.

What Early Saints missed...

- A truly restored 'church' would have been the Nephite Church. But we do not have it.
- Nephites were strict on sin, Restoration not in the same way.
- Being part of Nephite church meant abstaining from sin and being honest about it.
- This was/is never part of restoration practice, although we excommunicated many for drinking Coffee (what we call the word of wisdom).
- In Nephite church, Repentance brought free and full return, but this mercy is not practiced in the Restoration either
