Mormon 2:37-54 (LDS: Mormon 5:10)



<u>All these tell the same story, but it is a different story from</u> <u>Traditional Church Teaching</u>

The story of Zion is a promise to restore the House of Israel via the Covenant with Abraham.

Jesus Teaches Covenant with ABRAHAM

<u>3 Nephi 9:63</u> And behold, ye are the children of the prophets; And ye are of the house of Israel;

And ye are of the covenant which the Father made with your fathers, saying unto Abraham: 'And in thy Seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed ' (LDS: <u>3 Nephi 20:25</u>)

<u>3 Nephi 9:65</u> "And after that ye were blessed, then fulfilleth the Father the covenant which He made with Abraham saying:

In thy Seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed,

Unto the pouring out of the Holy Ghost through Me upon the Gentiles, Which blessing upon the Gentiles shall make them mighty above all, Unto the scattering of My people, O house of Israel; And they shall be a scourge unto the people of this land.

(LDS: <u>3 Nephi 20:28</u>) (Gentiles' blessing is because of Covenant with ABRAHAM!)

The Book of Mormon makes no mention of Enoch...

- EVERYTHING TAUGHT ABOUT ENOCH <u>COMES FROM EXTRA</u> <u>SCRIPTURAL SOURCES.</u>
- Lehi, Nephi, Jacob, King Benjamin, Jesus, Mormon, Moroni, Ether <u>NEVER MENTION ENOCH</u>.
- The Jaredites had the Creation story, but was not included in Book of Mormon because it is said these were had among the Jews.
- THE JAREDITES AND JEWS DID NOT HAVE THE ENOCH STORY WE HAVE BEEN TAUGHT IN THE RESTORATION.
- If Enoch is so vital in God's plan—(especially for us Gentiles), why did Lehi or Ether never explain it into their writings?

Enoch is missing from the Book of Mormon...

• Enoch,

- a covenant with Enoch,
- a city of Enoch on earth taken to Heaven,
- A promise for Enoch City to return...

....No Book of Mormon writers mention any of it...

Enoch was Popular among Freemasons In Joseph Smith's Day

Likely...as Joseph translated the 'New" Book of Mormon's, others close to Joseph (perhaps Hyrum) pointed to other 'new' information.

What was the foremost idea?

Enoch returning to earth.

'<u>Enoch</u>' was the <u>Indiana Jones</u> of the 1800's brought to you by Free Masons (like Hyrum Smith).

In a vision, <u>God transported Enoch to an arched vault deep</u> <u>underground</u> where he saw the name <u>engraved on a golden tablet.</u> <u>Enoch had a lavish temple built above the vault and sealed the</u> <u>underground chamber with a heavy iron trap door so that it would</u> <u>survive the coming flood, after which no one knew of the true name.</u>

....

Centuries later, Solomon dispatched three Masons to search in the ruins materials to embellish his own edifice. In the Masonic legend, <u>they find</u> <u>the trap door and despite their trepidation, descend into the darkness</u> <u>of the vault to find the golden tablet, which glows like the sun</u>.

The Ethiopian 'Kebra Nagast'

The story of Enoch city returning began in the 1700s when James Bruce returns from Ethiopia, with records to be translated. The Kebra NAGAST among others.

The Kebra Nagast was Ethiopian (Christian) writings written in Coptic (Egyptian).

James Bruce (Free Mason) had these translated. It was previously believed English Version didn't exist until 1900s, but has since been determined this was translated immediately (1700's). The Kebra Nagast was available via Masons in Joseph Smith's day.

Inspired Version Genesis:

7:67 And the Lord said unto Enoch, <mark>As I live, even so will I come in the last days</mark>, in the days of wickedness and vengeance, to fulfill the oath which I made unto you concerning the children of Noah.

Inspired Version Genesis 9:

20 And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud; and I will remember my covenant, which I have made between me and you, for every living creature of all flesh. And the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh.

21 And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant, which I made unto thy father Enoch; that, when men should keep all my commandments, Zion should again come on the earth, the city of Enoch which I have caught up unto myself.

114. Concerning the return of ZION

And the Tabernacle of the Law of God, the Holy ZION, shall remain here until that day when our Lord shall dwell on Mount ZION;

and ZION shall come and shall appear unto all prepared, with three seals even as MOSES gave her as it saith in the Old Law and in the New, "At the testimony of two or three (witnesses) everything shall stand."

And then, saith ISAIAH the Prophet, "The dead shall be raised up, and those who are in the graves shall live, for the dew which (cometh) from Thee is their life."

And when the dead are raised up, His mercy whereby He watereth the earth shall cease; they shall stand up before Him with the works which they have done. - The Book of Mormon teaches that <u>God has not forgotten his</u> <u>covenant with the Jews.</u>
- Yet, the Kebra Nagast condemns the Jews.

<u>Kebra Nagast condemns the Jews and</u> <u>Promotes Gentiles...</u>

• Condemns them To Hell

"And after the JEWS crucified the Saviour of the world, they were scattered abroad, and their kingdom was destroyed, <mark>and they were made an end of and</mark> rooted out for ever and ever..." (p. 85)

"...He shall judge the living and the dead and reward every man according to his work.

So therefore when the JEWS shall see Him they shall be put to shame, and shall be condemned to the fire which is everlasting.

But we who believe in the Orthodox Faith shall be upon our throne, and we shall rejoice with our teachers the Apostles..' (p. 95)

Summary about Restoration version of Enoch and Zion:

The Teachings of Enoch are distractions from the Covenant with Abraham, which truly foretells Zion.

Early Saints had Zion wrong:

Zion comes forth AFTER Scattering of Israel

2 Nephi 11:25 (LDS: 2 Nephi 25:15)

Wherefore, <u>the Jews shall be scattered among all nations</u>, Yea, and also Babylon shall be destroyed; Wherefore, the Jews shall be scattered by other nations,

And after that they have been scattered and the Lord God hath scourged them by other nations for the space of many

generations - Yea, even down from generation to generation until they shall be persuaded to believe in Christ, the Son of

God, and the atonement, which is infinite for all mankind –

2 Nephi 12:85 (LDS: 2 Nephi 30:7)

And it shall come to pass <u>that the Jews which are scattered also</u> <u>shall begin to believe in Christ; And they shall begin to gather in</u> <u>upon the face of the land</u>;

Early Saints had it wrong: Zion comes after Scattering and Return of Israel

<u>Mormon 2:49</u> (LDS: <u>Mormon 5:20</u>)

But behold, it shall come to pass that they (remnant) shall be driven and **scattered by the Gentiles**;

And <u>after that they have been driven and scattered by</u> <u>the Gentiles</u>, <u>Behold</u>, then will the Lord remember the <u>covenant which He made unto Abraham and unto all</u> <u>the house of Israel</u>;

37 And now behold, this I speak unto their seed, and also to the Gentiles which hath care for the house of Israel, that realize and know from whence their blessings come;

38 For I know that such will sorrow for the calamity of the house of Israel, Yea, they will sorrow for the destruction of this people; They will sorrow that this people had not repented, that they might have been clasped in the arms of Jesus.

39 Now these things are <u>written unto the</u> <u>remnant of the house of Jacob</u>, And they are written after this manner because it is known of God that wickedness will not bring them forth unto them, And they are to be hid up unto the Lord that they may come forth in His own due time; 40 And this is the commandment which I have received. 45 For behold, the Spirit of the Lord hath already ceased to strive with their fathers, And they are without Christ and God in the world, And they are driven about as chaff before the wind. 46 They were once a delightsome people and they had Christ for their Shepherd, yea, they were led, even by God the Father;

<u>47 But now behold, they are led about by</u> <u>Satan</u>, even as chaff is driven before the wind, or as a vessel is tossed about upon the waves without sail or anchor or without anything wherewith to steer her; And even as she is, so are they.

48 And behold, the Lord hath reserved their blessing, which they might have received in the land, for the Gentiles which shall possess the land.

49 But behold, it shall come to pass that they shall be driven and scattered by the Gentiles; And after that they have been driven and scattered by the Gentiles, Behold, then will the Lord remember the covenant which He made unto Abraham and unto all the house of Israel;

50 And also <u>the Lord will remember the</u> prayers of the righteous which hath been put <u>up unto Him for them.</u>

51 <u>And then, O ye Gentiles</u>, how can ye stand before the power of God except ye shall repent and turn from your evil ways? 52 Know ye not that ye are in the hands of God?

53 Know ye not that He hath all power and at His great command the earth shall be rolled together as a scroll?

54 Therefore, repent ye and humble yourselves before Him, lest He shall come out in justice against you - Lest a remnant of the seed of Jacob shall go forth among you as a lion and tear you in pieces and there is none to deliver.

Incorrect Assumptions by Early Church...

Early saints assumed Israel was gathering right behind them, gathering to Independence.

Gospel Returns to Israel BEFORE ZION

Behold, ' saith the Father,

Restorationists teach Gentiles will be gathered to one spot to experience 'Zion.'

• This is not mentioned in the Book of Mormon.



Instead, Book of Mormon Prophesies Church of Lamb Will Exist Throughout the World

<u>1 Nephi 3:</u> (LDS: <u>1 Nephi 14:10-12</u>)

224 And it came to pass that I looked and beheld the whore of all the earth; And she sat upon many waters;

225 And she had dominion over all the earth among all nations, kindreds, tongues and people.

226 And it came to pass that I beheld the church of the Lamb of God,

And its **<u>numbers were few because</u>** of the wickedness and abominations of the whore which sat upon many waters;

227 <u>Nevertheless</u>, I beheld that the church of the Lamb, which were the saints of God, were also upon all the face of the earth,

Only that it was deemed covenant land.

<u>Abraham Covenant—taught by the Bible</u>

1 Chronicles 16:14-16

14 He is the LORD our God; his judgments are in all the earth.
15 Be ye mindful always of his covenant; the word which he commanded to a thousand generations;
16 Even of the covenant which he made with Abraham, and of his oath unto Isaac;

Acts 3:25 Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed.

27 And he meaneth that it shall come by way of the Gentiles, that the Lord may show His power unto the Gentiles for the very cause that He shall be rejected of the Jews, or of the house of Israel.

Behold, He loved our fathers, And He covenanted with them, yea, even Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, And He remembered the covenants which He had made;

1 Nephi 7:20 (LDS: <u>1 Nephi 22:9</u>)

And not only unto the Gentiles, but unto all the house of Israel unto the **making known of the covenants of the Father of heaven unto Abraham**, saying: ' In thy Seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed. '

2 Nephi 12:74 (LDS: 2 Nephi 29:14)

And I will show unto them that fight against My word And against My people which are of the house of Israel, **That I Am God and that I covenanted with Abraham, That I would remember his seed forever.**

The Book of Mormon (always) promises unto ABRAHAM, never mentioning Enoch



Alma 5:42 (LDS: Alma 7:25)

And may the Lord bless you and keep your garments spotless, That ye may at last be brought to sit down with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob and the holy prophets which have been ever since the world began, <u>Having your garments spotless,</u> <u>even as their garments are spotless in the kingdom of heaven</u>. To go no more out.

(The End of the Covenant with Israel is Eternal Salvation)

Finally, Moroni Explains that New Jerusalem built and Old Jerusalem returning to God FULFILLS THE COVENANT WITH ABRAHAM (not Enoch).

Ether 6:10-13 10 And **then cometh the New Jerusalem**; And blessed are they which dwell therein, For it is they whose garments are white through the blood of the Lamb; And they are they which are numbered among the remnant of the seed of Joseph which were of the house of Israel.

11 And then also <u>cometh the Jerusalem of old</u> and the inhabitants thereof; Blessed are they, for they have been washed in the blood of the Lamb;

12 And they are they which were <u>scattered and gathered in from the four quarters of</u> <u>the earth and from the North Countries</u>, And are partakers of the fulfilling of the <u>covenant which God made with their father Abraham</u>.

13 And when these things come, bringeth to pass the scripture which saith, "There are they which were first, which shall be last, And there are they which were last, which shall be first."
