Se Matthew 24:3. *Tell us, when shall these ings be?* — There appear to be *three* questions usked here by the disciples.

1st. When shall these things be? viz. the destruction of the city, temple, and Jewish state.

2dly. *What shall be the sign of thy coming*? viz. to *execute* these judgments upon them, and to *establish* thy own Church: and

3dly. When shall this world end? When wilt thou come to judge the quick and the dead?

But there are some who maintain that these are but three parts of the *same* question, and that our Lord's answers only refer to the destruction of the Jewish state, and that nothing is spoken here concerning the

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Matt 24 and Abomination of Desolation = Roman **Armies Destroying** Jerusalem (according to Clarke)*

Verse 15

Verse Matthew 24:15. The abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel – This abomination of desolation, St. Luke, (Luke 21:20-21), refers to the *Roman army*; and this abomination standing in the holy place is the Roman army besieging Jerusalem; this, our Lord says, is what was spoken of by Daniel the prophet, in the *ninth* and *eleventh* chapters of his prophecy; and *so* let every one who reads these prophecies understand them; and in reference to this very event they are understood by the rabbins. The Roman army is called an abomination, for its ensigns and images, which were so to the Jews. Josephus says, (War, b. vi. chap. 6,) the Romans brought their ensigns into the temple, and placed them over against the eastern gate, and sacrificed to them there. The Roman army is therefore fitly called the *abomination*, and the abomination which maketh desolate, as it was to desolate and lay waste Jerusalem; and this army besieging Jerusalem is called by St. Mark, Mark 13:14, standing where it ought not, that is, as in the

Adam Clarke—Determines 'Neither The Son' to be Omitted from Mark 13

Verse Mark 13:32. *Neither the Son* – This clause is not found either in Matthew or Luke; and Ambrose says it was wanting in some Greek copies in his time. To me it is utterly unaccountable, how Jesus, who knew so *correctly* all the *particulars* which he here lays down, and which were to a jot and tittle verified by the event - how he who knew that not one stone should be left on *another*, should be ignorant of the day and hour when this should be done, though Daniel, Daniel 9:24, c., could fix the very *year*, not less than five hundred years before it happened: how he in whom the *fulness of the Godhead dwelt bodily*, and all the treasures of *wisdom* and *knowledge*, should not know this *small matter*. I cannot comprehend, but on this ground, that the Deity which dwelt in the man Christ Jesus might, at one time, communicate less of the knowledge of futurity to him than at another. However, I strongly suspect that the clause was not originally in this Gospel. Its

The Prophesied Restoration of Israel

- Israel's True restoration has not happened yet.
- Does not happen in the shadow of the Gentiles.
- Prophecy Indicates the Gentiles Deny God.
- How and Why? Like everyone else. Traditions become incorrect.
- The Restoration of Israel happens <u>when Gentiles Judged for Rejecting</u> <u>God.</u>

.. in the Hand of Ephraim?

- Saints 'assumed' this was us (latter day Gentiles).
- Saints incorrect assumptions for generations.
- Incorrect assumption about Zion.
- Also assumed Book of Mormon prophecy was about 'the 12' in Joseph Smith's day.*
- If Ezekiel 37 is literally about Ephraim, then it simply hasn't happened yet.
- There is a lot of history ahead!

*W.W. Phelps...(incorrectly writing Gentiles into Scripture, filling minds of early saints)

"...But I must begin to draw to a close, or my letter will be long enough for a pamphlet. I cannot leave the subject, however, <u>till I bring in the "Twelve." They were known from before the</u> <u>foundation of the world, and are thus noticed in the prophecy of Zenos, in the Book of Mormon; I</u> <u>mean in that masterly parable of the "olive tree:" All men, acquainted with revelation and the</u> <u>spirit of God, have agreed that the "servant" spoken of in that parable, was Joseph Smith, and</u> <u>when the Lord commanded him "to go to and call other servants," and "they did go to it with their</u> <u>mights,"</u>-as the whole has been backed up by revelations in the Book of Doctrine and Covenants, it would require more than "mortal" to prove that allusion to the "servants," meant any body but the "Twelve."

I know the Twelve, and they know me.-Their names are Brigham Young, the lion of the Lord; Heber C. Kimball, the herald of grace; Parley P. Pratt, the archer of paradise; Orson Hyde, the olive branch of Israel; Willard Richards, the keeper of the rolls: John Taylor, the champion of right; William Smith, the entablature of truth; Orson Pratt, the gauge of philosophy; John E. Page, the sun dial; and Lyman Wight, the wild ram of the mountain. And they are good men; the best the Lord can find; they do the will of God, and the saints know it.

- Book of Abraham....(incorrectly Translated about Egyptian death)
- A Nephite bones named Zelph...(bones won't last 100 years on surface)
- Early promises of living in Zion...(assumed this was about Gentiles)
- Promises about Enoch City....(not in Book of Mormon)

The main reason why the printing press was destroyed, was because they published the Book of Commandments.

It fell into the hands of the world, and the people of Jackson county, Missouri, saw from the revelations that they were considered by the church as intruders upon the land of Zion, as enemies to the church, and that they should be cut off out of the land of Zion and sent away.

- <u>Herschel is alleged to have observed creatures that look like bison,</u> <u>goats, unicorns, and tail-less beavers in forests on the moon</u>. <u>The</u> <u>most stunning find, however, was the discovery of human-bat</u> <u>creatures who had constructed temples on the moon</u>.
- These stories brought considerable attention to the *New York Sun*. People around the world were interested in learning about the inhabitants of the moon.



Brigham Young: the Sun & Moon were Inhabited

- Kolob is a star or planet described in the <u>Book of Abraham</u>, a sacred text of the <u>Latter Day Saint movement</u>. Several Latter Day Saint denominations hold the Book of Abraham to have been translated from an <u>Egyptian papyrus scroll</u> by <u>Joseph Smith</u>...
- According to this work, Kolob is the heavenly body nearest to the <u>throne of God</u>.
- While the Book of Abraham calls Kolob a "star",^[1] it also calls planets "stars",^[2] and therefore some Latter Day Saint commentators consider Kolob a planet.^[3]
- The body also appears in <u>Latter Day Saint culture</u>, including a reference to Kolob in an LDS <u>hymn</u>.^[4]

The Book of Abraham???

The Egyptian manuscript that Joseph Smith 2 claimed was the Book of Abraham is known as the Joseph Smith Papyri.

It is a collection of several papyrus fragments that Smith purchased from an antiquities dealer in 1835.

Smith believed that one of the fragments contained the writings of the biblical patriarch Abraham, which he then translated into English and published as the Book of Abraham.

The Book of Abraham Incorrectly Translated

Modern Egyptologists, however, have examined the same papyrus fragments and have determined that they are actually part of a funerary text known as the Book of Breathings, a common Egyptian funerary text that was used during the time of the Pharaohs.

The Book of Abraham Incorrectly Translated

The text was a guide to help the deceased navigate the afterlife and was typically buried with the deceased.

The papyrus fragments contain no mention of Abraham, and the hieroglyphics on the fragments are not a translation of the text that Smith claimed to have translated.

The Book of Abraham???

Furthermore, the manuscript has been dated to the first century BC, which is long after the time of Abraham.

Egyptologists have concluded that the papyrus was likely created as a copy of an earlier text that may have contained a version of the Book of Breathings.

So where does 'Ephraim' Come Into Latter Day Doctrine?

- First mention in Church History is Ezekiel 37.
-Then ASSUMED this is us because the Book of Mormon is 'in our hands.'

(Saints were expelled from Jackson County in 1833, did not return By any number until 1860's)

Oliver Snow on June 20, 1836

"...Thou shalt live to see the tribes come in from the North..."

Isaac Rogers on December 3, 1836

- But what did this type of language produce early on?
- It produced <u>Traditions of belief</u>, and a manner of language among the Gentiles, Unique to the Gentiles.

The real question: WHY DID SAINTS GET SO FAR DOWN THIS PATH OF THINKING?

- Likely a mis-reading of the Book of Mormon.
- 1 Nephi 7 (and other chapters) deals with prophetic future. Misunderstood these events to be immediately upon the Gentiles.
- What we learn from specific reading of 1 Nephi 7 is the 'speedy' events, were all hinged upon judgement upon the Great and Abominable church.
- This event did not happen in the days of Joseph Smith, nor has it happened yet in the history of Gentiles.
- This event is STILL IN THE FUTURE.
- Early saints thought these events were to transpire then.

"The Kingdom" Incorrectly taught in Mormon history...but became Tradition for some...

"...for know ye not that there is Zion? know ye not that there is Zion?

We have had Zion upon the earth this fourteen years.

- "There is no clear evidence that Psalm 110:4 was added by scribes, but the sudden appearance of the figure of Melchizedek and the absence of any reference to an existing priestly order have led many scholars to question its originality." (Tremper Longman III, How to Read the Psalms, 1988)

The Anchor Bible Commentary: Psalms 101-150, by Mitchell Dahood, page 203. Dahood argues that the reference to Melchizedek was added later to the psalm to emphasize the royal and priestly aspects of the king's reign. (Return)

Why ask this question?

- Was Melchizedek a biblical topic like the Moon was in 1830s?
- Because the idea of a Melchizedek Order became a tradition after the Bablyonian conquest.
- NO MENTION OF MELCHIZEDEK PRIESTHOOD in BOOK OF MORMON
- Book of Mormon improves on this, ONLY MENTIONS PRIESTHOOD after the ORDER of GOD.
- (A rose by any other name...)



This is a Debate. But WHY ASK THE QUESTION?

Fact: The BOOK OF MORMON makes NO MENTION of a MELCHIZEDEK ORDER

Instead, the Book of Mormon is 'greater than this' indicating priesthood is ONLY AFTER THE ORDER OF GOD!



Furthermore....

- Reasoning is to 'avoid too frequent mention of the name of God'
- ... Who benefits from that?

DC 104:1a There are, in the church, two priesthoods; namely: the **Melchisedec**, and the Aaronic, including the Levitical priesthood.

DC 104:1b Why the first is called the **Melchisedec** priesthood, is because **Melchisedec** was such a great high priest: <u>before his day it was</u> called the holy priesthood, after the order of the Son of God;

DC 104:1c but out of respect or reverence to the name of the Supreme Being, to avoid the too frequent repetition of his name, they, the church, in ancient days, called that priesthood after Melchisedec, or the Melchisedec priesthood.
